B. Registration

- i. Please register online at www.motorsportsreg.com. Drivers without internet access may request a paper entry from the chief registrar by phone or email.
- ii. Online registration closes at 3 PM Friday October 24, 2025.
- iii. Telephone, email, or online registration is not official until all fees are received.
- iv. Registration hours at the track are listed below:

Additional times available by appointment.

- v. If your competition license is pending, please contact the Chief Registrar **before** Tuesday, October 21, 2025, to allow time to verify the license status.

D. Payments

- i. If you register online, payment may be made by credit card. You may opt to pay by mail (check or money order) or at the track; cash and checks are accepted at the track.
- ii. If sending payment by mail or delivery, the Registrar is not responsible for any entries or payment requiring a signature or special pickup.
- iii. If you pay by check through the mail, please ensure the Chief Registrar receives the check by Monday, October 20, 2025.

iv. Make checks payable to *Neohio Region Inc, SCCA*.

E. Cancellations/Refunds

- i. Cancellations must be in writing; email is acceptable.
- ii. Cancellation must be received **before** October 24, 2025; otherwise, no refund will be given.
- iii. If a car turns a wheel on track for any session, no refund will be given.
- iv. Full refunds will be given if the written cancellation is received on or before 9 pm, Thursday, October 23, 2025. After that deadline, cancellations will be assessed a \$50 fee.

F. Pursuit Race Rules ~~Race Experience~~

- i. 12-Lap Closed Wheel Pursuit Race will be the last event on Saturday.
- ii. Open to competitors in the following classes: SM, SMX, SR, SRF, SRF3, ITE, ITR, ITS, ITA, IT7, ITB, ITC, SP, SPU, STL, STU, T3, T4, EP, FP, HP, GTL, B-Spec, C-Spec
- iii. Handicap and start position will be based on best time from the day.
- iv. Trophies will be awarded to the top three drivers.
- v. Additional rules will be presented the day of the event.
- ~~vi. A one hour Race Experience will take place on Saturday.~~
- ~~vii. Open to GCR Sedans in select classes and non-GCR cars that meet Race Experience Rules~~
- ~~viii. Racers participating in the club race, same car, same driver may add the Race Experience event for an added entry fee of \$125~~
- ~~ix. Race Experience entry includes separate Practice and Qualifying Sessions~~
- x. ~~Race Experience Supplemental rules are available from a separate link on the MSR event page~~

G. Time Trials

- i. A separate Time Trial event is taking place this weekend
- ii. Up to two Time Trial Groups will participate on Sunday and their sessions will be slotted between Race Group Sessions (Listen to announcements and watch the Schedule!!!)
- iii. Time Trial Supplemental rules are available on a separate MSR event page

II. DRIVER INFORMATION

The Divisional Race is open to all drivers holding a valid SCCA membership and Club Race license as well as recognized SCCA-approved organizations per GCR 3.1.2.C.1-3.

A. Technical Inspection

- i. All drivers without a current year helmet sticker must present all driver gear at tech, with their SCCA logbook, and completed tech sheet.
- ii. If a car requires an annual tech or there are notations in the SCCA logbook, they must be inspected. Contact Maurice LaFond at 440-946-2207 (6-9 pm only) prior to the event.
- iii. If your car needs decals per GCR 9.3.29.C (Figure 4), tech will provide them for a fee.
- iv. Tech hours are as follows:

Friday, October 24, 2025	5 - 8 pm
Saturday, October 25, 2025	7:00 am open (scale hours will be posted)
Sunday, October 26, 2025	7:00 am open (scale hours will be posted)

B. Black Flag Station – In addition to Start/Finish, the black flag may be displayed at station 10 or 11.

C. Sound Limit – 103 dB measured outside turn 13.

D. 2-Way Radios – The following frequencies are not permitted by teams or drivers: 151.760, 462.5625, 464.500, 456.800.

- E. **Contact** – Any on-track contact that causes erratic car behavior, results in a change of position, causes a car(s) leaving the course, or results in property damage must report to the Black Flag station in pit lane.
- F. **Pass Under Yellow** – All PUYs will be investigated per GCR 6.1.1.B.
- G. **Damage to Track Property** – Damage to track property not covered by SCCA insurance will be billed to the person who caused the damage.
- H. **Awards** – Awards might be distributed after the event. Make sure the Race Chair has your current contact information.

III. CAR ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

A. Classes

- i. Competition is open to cars conforming to the current GCR as amended in FasTrack.
- ii. Classes are listed in the 2025 Great Lakes Division Regional Championship Series rules.
- iii. Sports R (SR) for all Sports Racers powered by Renault engines, per rules at www.Neohioscca.com/club-racing.

B. **Preferred Numbers** – Every effort will be made to give you the number requested. However, due to multiple-class groups, it may not be possible. Requests for the same number will go to the driver whose entry is received first.

C. Transponders

- i. All competition cars must have a **working** MyLaps (formerly AMB) transponder.
- ii. Correct transponder numbers must be provided on the entry form, to the Registrar, or to the Chief of T&S.
- iii. Cars with non-working transponders will not be scored.

D. **Cameras** – Per GCR 9.3.11.A, all competition cars require **working** forward-facing cameras whenever on track. Ensure a clean, working card is installed correctly in the camera.

IV. ROAD RACE QUALIFYING

- **Saturday**

- Qualifying session – Grid arrival time (First come, first served)
- Race – set by fastest qualifying times from Saturday Qualifying

- **Sunday**

- Qualifying session – Grid arrival time (First come, first served)
- Race – set by fastest qualifying from Sunday Qualifying

V. TRACK RULES

A. Wristbands

- i. SCCA provided Wristbands must be worn at all times.
- ii. Participants without wristbands will not have access to hot areas (grid, pits anywhere between spectator barriers and the race track).

B. During on-track sessions, only one crew member may stand at the pit wall to signal a driver at the discretion of the Chief of Pits.

C. **Paddock Parking** – No Race Trailers/Paddock set-ups are allowed east of the stop sign adjacent to the Shower House.

D. Two-, Three-, and Four-wheeled Vehicles

- i. Non-competition vehicles are allowed only for race officials or as race support vehicles.

- ii. All race support vehicles must prominently display the approved racecar number and class.
- iii. All drivers must be 18 years of age or older.
- E.** Riding on the outside of any vehicle or trailer is strictly prohibited.
- F.** Traffic on the bridge is restricted to light vehicles only.
- G.** Unmuffled engines are **strictly prohibited between 8:00 pm and 7:00 am.**
- H.** Absolutely no testing of racecars off the track premises or on any public roads.
- I. Fuel**
 - i. Fuel may be available at the track. Contact the track for more information.
 - ii. Any driver/team with more than 40 gallons of fuel must notify the Safety Steward and Chief of Emergency Services regarding their paddock location.
- J. Camping**
 - i. Camping is available for a fee.
 - ii. Hookups are **not** available.
 - iii. Campfires must always be contained and attended by an adult; accelerants are prohibited.
- K.** Pets must always be leashed and attended by an adult. Please clean up after your pet.
- L.** Competitors must remove all tires and used automotive fluids from the premises. Please clean your area before departure.
- M. Motorhome and semi-trailer owners:** Please contact the track at 330-977-0111 before arrival for parking locations.
