Thank you for your commitment to instruct at our Windy City BMW High Performance Driving Experience (HPDE) at Autobahn on Saturday and Sunday, May 20 & 21, 2023. Instructor day is May 19th

See the driver letter – attached- for the rest of the information on the experience, times, maps, sample waivers, Covid Waiver, car insurance option info, etc.

Red and yellow groups will have assigned instructors. Green group will be able to choose an instructor, if they wish, from a separate instructor pool.

Green Run Group information:

- There will be a Solo run group. Solo run group drivers are highly experienced HPDE participants. Eligibility for this run group will be decided by the DEC. The Solo run group will run in their own group and also be allowed to run with the instructor group. Instructors can drive in the Solo group.
- 2. Solo participants will have the opportunity to select an instructor for a session. This gives the experienced HPDE participant the opportunity to continue learning.

Instructor / Driver pairing assignments will be sent via email before the event. Please contact your driver(s) ahead of time to discuss their goals, skill level, car modifications, previous track-driving experience, etc.

Technical Inspection: The form is attached. You must present the signed/certified tech inspection sheet at registration on the day of the event. You must sign the form as participant.

Your car must pass inspection before coming to the event. Bob Rauch Auto Care (847-235-2204) or Ben Rogut (7th Gear) (224-659-3461) can do inspections by appointment only at their shops for a fee. Addresses are on the Motorsportsreg page. There will be NO onsite inspections. There will be NO Chapter pre-tech event. Your vehicle's status is subject to review by the event Tech Steward if questionable conditions are noted. No refunds are given if unsafe vehicles are brought to the event. If in your role as an instructor you detect a safety issue with your student's car please alert the Chief Steward

The technical inspection is for your safety and the safety of others on the track with you. As this is a BMW CCA national requirement THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE.

Friday Instructor Day: The instructors' track time will be <u>Friday</u>, May19th from 8:30 to 5:00. If you cancel more than 24 hours before the Friday Instructor Day (9:00 on 5/18), you will receive a 90% refund for that day. Otherwise there will be no refund.

Call Randy Everson @ 847-274-7129 for questions.

There will be designated instructor/green group track sessions on Saturday and Sunday. No racing will be allowed. This applies for the whole weekend.

Car: It must be in the car you registered in and must be quiet. If you have a change in cars after registering, notify Randy Everson.

Helmets: Helmets must be SNELL or SFI 2015 or newer. Helmets have to be checked at the track registration if you don't already have a current Windy City BMW inspection sticker (yellow or red).

Parking at Autobahn: As you pull in and drive toward the Member Club House building (straight in front of you), park anywhere between the two towers (paddocks B & C). The members have all the parking near the Member Club house (paddocks A & D).

At the front gate you must sign the Autobahn liability waiver and the one for Windy City BMW which sign away your rights and get your ACC wristband. A copy of our waiver is enclosed, please review it. Our registration will be held in the South Tech Barn and you will be given your (checkered) event wristband there..

Saturday and Sunday Morning: The track opens at 7:00 AM. Registration from 7:00 till 7:30 in the south Tech Barn. Mandatory Instructor / Driver combined meeting at 8:00 by the Tech Barn. Drivers will be introduced to their Instructors.

You can do a simple paddock check of your driver's car before the first time out on Saturday morning. Please do this same check on Sunday if you have a Sunday-only driver. If you find any safety issues, let an event Chairperson know.

Miscellaneous

You will need a communicator, please be prepared and bring one.

All instructors must have a full operator's license that is not suspended or revoked. Equal restraints are needed. If you have a harness, then your passenger needs a harness. Cars must have mufflers in working order to run.

If you cause property damage at the track, you are responsible for the repair cost.

Driver Evaluation Form: One is enclosed to review. Refer to it as you work with your drivers to be sure all points are covered in your instruction. These are the areas of skills we most want to teach. We recommend that after your drivers' last track time you discuss their progress (or lack thereof) during the HPDE. The Committee reviews each evaluation to be able to place the driver in the appropriate run group at their next HPDE. Please let our Chief Instructor know if you instruct a driver who you feel has both the skills and the interest in becoming an instructor. They could be invited to attend a future Instructor Training School to keep our instructor base growing. You should also evaluate any Intermediate drivers for possible attendance at our August Blackhawk HPDE.

Important points:

- * Keep a safe distance from the car in front of you except to pass.
- * If you or your driver has a 360 degree or more spin or four wheels off the track you <u>must</u> come into the pit area to be checked.
- * Racing will NOT be tolerated. ANYONE ENGAGED IN RACING WILL BE EXPELLED, NO EXCEPTIONS, NO REFUNDS.

NO CONVERTIBLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK without a hardtop and SCCA type roll bar/cage

Gasoline & Air: Air and fuel are available at the track (expensive) or 15 minutes away at normal pump prices.

Concession Stand: The concession stand will be open each day for lunch or you can go off-site. Your schedule has rest periods to allow time for you to eat.

Speed limit in the paddock is 15mph. Speed limit on all access roads is 25mph. No bedding of brakes or testing of vehicles is allowed on access roads.

Asphalt Protection-All awnings and tents must be secured. Pounding stakes or making holes in the asphalt is not allowed for any reason. Any jacks must have wood or metal underneath to prevent damaging the asphalt. No painting any asphalt surfaces.

Waste Fluids-All waste fluid must be disposed of at the collection center located to the east of the North Timing Tower. Any spills must be reported immediately for proper clean up. Used tires and unwanted parts must be removed by the participant.

Pit Vehicles-Any pit vehicles must be operated by licensed drivers only. Use is restricted to the paddock area. Children are not allowed to operate these vehicles.

Bicycles, roller blades and skateboards are not allowed.

Pets are permitted on the grounds but must be kept on a leash at all times. Pet owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.

Fireworks and Weapons-No fireworks or weapons are allowed anywhere in the facility.

Music-No loud music, or music that includes obscenities, is allowed.

Fires-No camp fires are allowed.

Hook-ups for electric are available on a very limited basis to event organizers only and must be prearranged. Unauthorized parties are not allowed to plug into any buildings.

Alcohol-No alcohol is permitted in the pits or paddock until the track events for the day have been completed.

Marijuana-No Marijuana (smoking materials, foodstuffs or in any other form) is permitted within the Autobahn Country Club property. **Viewing Areas** All spectators and participants must stay in designated viewing areas. Access roads to perimeter garages are private and limited to authorized personnel only. These areas are marked with "no spectators" signs.

Camping Overnight camping is allowed at certain events. All persons staying overnight need to pay the camping fee upon registration. All overnight vehicles must display a camping permit in the front window. Complete camping rules are available at the registration desk; no electric hook-up is available. Contact the track directly.

Café The Autobahn Café serves upscale fast food with an emphasis on quality. The Café is always open for lunch, and often for breakfast at the client's request. The Food and Beverage staff is available for any level of catering—please contact Peggy Gerdes for services and hours.

Pre/Post Event Parking No trailers or vehicles may enter the premises prior to the day of an event unless prior arrangements have been made. All participants and vehicles must exit the premises before the registration gate closes on the last day of an event. Please contact Mike Gritter to make arrangements for any trailers or vehicles that must be delivered prior to the first day of an event.

Restrooms and Showers Restrooms are located in both the North and South timing towers, as well as at the café. Showers are available and located in the North and South Tower.

Fuel Fuel pumps are located to the east of the café near the circle. 93 and 104 unleaded as well as 110 leaded fuel is available. All pumps accept credit cards, no cash sales. Corporate events may request to set up a credit program with the accounting office. Additional services may be provided with prior notification. Please be aware if debit cards are used a \$150 hold will be placed on the account, this may be reflected on accounts for up to 3 days before the unused balance is removed.

Internet Wireless internet is available to the public throughout all the buildings and in the paddock area, no passwords are needed.

Noise Restrictions A 105db noise limit is strictly enforced. No race engines may be started before 8:00 am or after 8:00 pm.

Public Address System The PA system can be heard on 103.7 FM. The PA system is available for use upon request.

Vendors No vendors or sales of any kind are allowed without written permission from Autobahn Country Club. ALL vendors must supply an insurance certificate and are subject to vendor fees.

Banners/Flyers No banners or printed material may be hung on any facilities or structures without **prior** consent. No flyers or handbills may be distributed.

Photographers Photographers and anyone taking video must receive permission to do so. Photo vests are available from Track Operations and must be worn at all times by all professional photographers who wish to go beyond the general paddock areas, they must also identify themselves to "race control" and follow all instructions. Autobahn photographers are available upon request.

Kart Track Go Kart rental may be available on a limited basis. Please contact Brandon Haygood.

Re-cycling – Autobahn is going green this year. If you have a desire to re-cycle,

there is a bin located next to our café. Please do not throw glass in with the re-cycling, just paper, plastic and aluminum.
