



ABOUT RMM PUBLIC TRACK DAYS

Challenge your driving skill and take your vehicle to its performance limits at an RMM open-lapping track day. Open-lapping is a non-timed, open-track driving event, that allows drivers to experience the 3.5 km, 16-turn RMM circuit at their own pace.

Prior to participating in an RMM Public Track Day, drivers will be required to provide proof of previous race track experience. RMM is committed to providing a safe environment for all participants and this stipulation will ensure that all drivers are competent. Drivers will participate in one of three groups—Novice, Intermediate, or Experienced.

Drivers that do not hold sufficient prior track experience can obtain access through the completion of a RMM Beginner Track Experience Program. This half-day driving school is a one-time requirement and will provide the necessary driving education to join public open-lapping events at RMM. Check our calendar for available RMM Track Schools.

RMM PUBLIC TRACK DAY CHECKLIST

1. Sign up for the appropriate group based on your experience/confidence level
2. Familiarize yourself with our track rules and regulations including RMM sound limits
3. Familiarize yourself with our lapping procedures
4. Complete the RMM vehicle technical checklist prior to arrival. Download at event listing.
5. Arrive with a full tank of fuel
6. Arrive on time for the mandatory driver briefing



TRACK DAY GROUPS

NOVICE GROUP

Novice drivers will have minimal track experience and may not be familiar with proper driving lines or track procedures. Novice Group participants can expect to drive at a safe and controlled pace, while learning the RMM circuit.

Novice Group drivers will be led by an instructor pace car in a lead-follow environment for all driving sessions.

Passing is not permitted in the Novice Group. This will allow drivers to focus on what's ahead while not feeling pressured by the presence of other cars on track.

We recommended inexperienced drivers select the Novice Group for their first track event until an instructor deems them prepared to advance to a higher skill-level group.

NOVICE GROUP REQUIREMENTS

To participate in a Novice Group session, drivers must provide proof of ONE of the following:

- Completion of an RMM Beginner Track Experience Course
- Completion of an RMM High-Performance Driving Course
- Completion of 1-day accredited driving school (Example: Skip Barber, Jim Russel, Bob Bondurant, Spring Mountain, Area 27 Racing Academy, Allen Berg Racing School)
- 3 days of open-lapping experience at any racing circuit (within the past 5 years)



TRACK DAY GROUPS

INTERMEDIATE GROUP

Intermediate Group participants are drivers who are confident in their driving abilities and are able to lap at a higher speed as they continue to build on their circuit experience.

Intermediate Groups will begin the day with one full session of lead-follow. Subsequent sessions will be in an open-lapping format.

Intermediate Group passing will be limited to the front straight only. RMM Track Day passing rules will apply.

INTERMEDIATE GROUP REQUIREMENTS

To participate in an Intermediate Group session, drivers must provide proof of ONE of the following:

- Completion of an RMM High-Performance Driving Course
- 1-day RMM open-lapping in the Novice Group (subject to approval)
- Completion of a 3-day accredited driving school (Example: Skip Barber, Jim Russel, Bob Bondurant, Spring Mountain, Area 27 Racing Academy, Allen Berg Racing School)
- 5 days of open-lapping experience at any racing circuit (within the past 10 years)
- Accredited race license holder (within the past 30 years)



TRACK DAY GROUPS

EXPERIENCED GROUP

Experienced Group participants are drivers with an extensive amount of previous race track experience, who are fully capable of lapping at high speeds, while maintaining the driving line and proper driving techniques.

Experienced Groups will begin their first session with a few laps of lead-follow before being released by the instructor to continue the lapping session at their own pace. Subsequent sessions will be in an open-lapping format.

Experienced Group passing will be permitted in all designated passing zones. RMM Track Day passing rules will apply.

Drivers must show a consistent ability to safely maintain an appropriate level of speed and vehicle control to remain in the Experienced Group.

EXPERIENCED GROUP REQUIREMENTS

To participate in an Experienced Group session, drivers must provide proof of ONE of the following:

- Completion of an RMM High-Performance Driving Course (subject to approval)
- 1-day RMM open-lapping in the Intermediate Group (subject to approval)
- 10 days of open-lapping experience at any racing circuit (within the past 10 years)
- Accredited race license holder (within the past 15 years)



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

How do I show experience proof for my group?

RMM will review your history through MotorsportReg. Registrants can add previous track experience to their profile if attended outside the MotorsportReg system. The more details you can provide the better. For example: dates, locations, vehicles used, courses completed, etc) If RMM determines you are in the wrong group, you will be contacted

How many vehicles in a run group?

15

Can I share a car?

Yes. In this case, both drivers will pay the full entrance fee. Drivers can alternate over sessions or run in different groups to maximize individual track time

How much track time is there?

A driver can expect to participate in approximately four 25-minute sessions in each group

Can I bring a passenger?

Yes. The following conditions apply:

- Passengers are permitted in "lead-follow" sessions only
- They can be front seat passengers only
- Passengers must adhere to Alberta Transportation Size Regulations. (children)
- Passengers must wear helmets
- Passengers are an additional cost of \$50

Is the event weather dependant?

No. RMM Track Days will operate rain or shine *see cancellation/refund policy

How do I know if I have sufficient prior experience?

For full details, see the individual driving group requirements

Does the RMM Half-day Beginner Track Experience course qualify me for RMM open-lapping events?

Yes. This course qualifies you to participate in our Novice Group lapping sessions.

Are convertibles without roll protection allowed on track?

Yes, in the Novice Group sessions only. No passing is permitted.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is passing allowed at RMM Track Days?

Passing is permitted in the Intermediate and Experienced Groups and in designated passing zones only. RMM Track Day passing rules apply.

What is an approved vehicle?

Any performance-oriented car that is well-maintained, and capable of being driven at high speeds for an extended duration. Please review our vehicle technical checklist for more details.

Are trucks, SUVs, and vans allowed?

Approved SUVs can participate in Novice Group only. No large SUVs, trucks, or vehicles with a high centre of gravity.

Can I bring friends and family to watch?

Yes. RMM currently has limited spectator viewing areas. We recommend bringing a portable chair.

Are there helmets available for rental?

Yes \$10.00 each

Are there vehicles available to rent from the track?

No. You must provide your own vehicle

Does the entrant fee include the GPS unit rental?

Yes

Does the RMM open-lapping count towards my non-member access policy?

Yes

Can I sign up to be a member of RMM and enjoy unlimited access?

Yes

Can I bring my purpose-built race car to an RMM Track Day?

Yes, as long as it meets the specified RMM sound requirements, and is a vehicle designed for street-use.

Are motorcycles allowed?

RMM Motorcycle track days are in collaboration with HardNox. Please visit their website to book available dates.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I bring my own driving coach?

Non RMM instructors are subject to an instructor fee, and must be pre-approved by RMM before arrival.

Is the open-lapping on the full track, or partial track?

Full Track—RMM consists of 16 turns over a 3.5 km circuit

Can I move up into a higher grouping once I feel more confident and gain more experience?

Yes, under approval of a present RMM Staff Member.

What is appropriate attire for the event?

Footwear needs to be closed toed shoes (No sandals, no heels) Athletic attire is recommended (light material). Please see a more detailed list in general rules and regulations.

What is an approved helmet?

- Automobile sessions require an automobile-specific safety helmet
- Motorcycle/Motocross helmets are NOT approved for automobile sessions
- Only Snell SA2010 (or higher) rated helmets are accepted
- DOT rated helmets will NOT be accepted
- Helmets are available for rental

Is there a noise limitation at the track?

Yes. The noise limit at RMM is 95db at wide open throttle (WOT) measured 10 meters from the track edge. Vehicles that do not meet the specified sound limitations will not be permitted to continue.

What are my food options during an RMM Public Track Day?

Lunch is provided at all RMM Public Track Days, but you're always welcome to pack your own. Please note: While RMM will try to ensure a variety of food options such as vegetarian and gluten-free, we may not be able to accommodate all specific food intolerances or food allergies.

What is the RMM refund/cancellation policy?

Cash Refunds will be provided up to 5 days before the event. Refunds outside this timeframe will be given as Credit. If your vehicle does not meet RMM sound requirements, a credit will be given. All RMM Events go forward, rain or shine. *In the case where an event needs to be cancelled due to extreme weather, the event will be rescheduled.
