

2019 Put-in-Bay Sports Car Races

Race Car Eligibility

The **2019 Put-in-Bay Sportscar Races** seek to celebrate, capture and preserve the history of the races that were held at Put-in-Bay "back in the day." The original races limited entries to sports cars under 2.0L and sports racers under 1.5L. Other appropriate cars will be considered by application for this event however. - **Original Era (thru-1963) Sports Cars & Sedans;** C, D, E, F, G, H-Production.
- **Original Era (thru-1963) Racing Sports Cars & Modifieds;** F, G, H-Modified.
- **Post Era (1964 thru 1972);** Production Cars (3.0L limit)* and Sport-Racing Cars (2.0L limit)*
- **Open Wheel;** Formula Jr, Formula Vee, Quantum Formula-S, Formula 3, Formula Ford.
- **Featured "Tin Top" Sedans:** Sedans are defined as 2 or 4 door family cars and their racing derivatives. Sedan eligibility will include up 1972 cars that raced as B, C and D Sedan under SCCA rules and FIA Groups 1 and 2. Certain examples may be given waivers on displacement over 3.0L, i.e. Falcon, Comet, Mustang, Valiant, Dodge Dart, Jaguar MK II, etc.
- **Racing Exhibition:** Open track, limited passing non-race format. Open to eligible cars whose drivers may not wish to drive in a competitive race environment. Also, select cars that may not qualify in the above categories but are deemed appropriate by the event organizers; by special application.

The organizers will consider applications outside these listed parameters when appropriate to the concepts, standards and philosophy of the Put-in-Bay Sports Car Races.
