Thank you for supporting SOVREN's 36th Annual Pacific Northwest Historics celebrating Ferrari Race Cars with your participation as a race official.

Pacific Raceways' 2.25-mile road course has a legendary past. Built in 1959 and first opened in 1960, the 10-turn road course was a mainstay on the USAC and Trans Am schedule in the 1960s and '70s. A veritable Who's Who of road racing greats have called on Pacific Raceways' technically challenging road course including Mario Andretti, Parnelli Jones, Dan Gurney, Mark Donohue, and Dale Earnhardt to name a few. Amenities include a concession stand (Top Beer Concessions), and Showers available in the west end Restrooms near the car corral, bring quarters. A Road Course Track Map is available [HERE](#). FIRE MARSHALL REQUIREMENTS:

- ★ **NO FIRE PITS OR COOKING FIRES under awnings, tents, or canopies**

GENERAL RACING/TRACK INFORMATION:

- ★ Pacific Raceways **does not allow anyone under 16** to operate a wheeled vehicle in the Paddock. Those on bicycles/scooters/pit carts should exercise caution in the congested Paddock.
- ★ Pacific Raceways policy regarding alcoholic beverages is, **"No alcohol is allowed on the premises except in designated areas."**
- ★ All Dogs must be always on a leash or confined. Please don't leave them outside alone. Please be considerate and clean up after your pup.
- ★ Please make sure your area is in **a clean and tidy condition before you leave** the track at the end of the event. - all trash in proper receptacles!
- ★ Overnight stays are permitted in designated areas only. Tents are discouraged.

MOVE IN

Because of the 2-Day event "Women in Racing" the paddock will have to strategically be loaded in. Please respect the event at ProFormance and be patient and kind as we work through this awkward situation.

- ★ Please pull to the right-hand lane and wait for your move-in time.
- ★ Do not enter the paddock until directed to do so. We ask that unless you are part of a set up crew that you refrain from entering the paddock until after 5PM.

At 5 PM anyone needing to cross the track at turn 8 to park will be allowed. Please be careful crossing a cold track, crews will be setting the track for the next day. See "Camping" for more information.

PADDOCK PARKING

- ★ Each official will be given **1 OFFICIAL PADDOCK PASS** (per vehicle) for your vehicle that will be traveling each day into / through the paddock. You will need to write your name on the pass.
- ★ **The pass must be visibly displayed on the dash, in the windshield, of your vehicle, at all times.**

REGISTRATION - Each participant must sign, or have signed, a waiver. An event wristband will be distributed at registration and must be worn to obtain access to the paddock. Security will be checking wristbands all weekend starting early Friday morning. You will need to come to Registration in person to receive your wristband.

REGISTRATION HOURS: Thursday: 11:00-7:00; Friday 7:00-2:00 Saturday 7:00-2:00; Sunday 7:30-1:30

OFFICIAL'S "WORKER" MEETING: Each day at 8:00AM held in the infield area behind the turn 9 grandstands. Coffee and Donuts/Pastry will be available. Flag training/refresher meeting will be held in the same location at 7:30AM.

CAMPING: There is no camping allowed in the grass by the bathrooms closest to the office without permission from the track. Camping is permitted behind the tower. Tents are best placed in the hollow behind the big grandstands overlooking turns 6-7. In this area tents do not need to be removed during the day, but people are advised not to leave any possessions in their tents as spectators do have access to this area. RV's and all vehicles need to be locked. SOVREN will not take responsibility for stolen items.

LUNCHES: SOVREN provides lunch tickets for all registered Race Workers. Lunch counts will be taken at the worker meeting, or within your specialty. Lunch choice may vary day to day but generally include Hamburger or Cheeseburger or Hot Dog with Fries, or a selection of sandwiches with chips. All lunches include beverage.

LUNCH TIME ACTIVITIES: All workers wanting to cross the track to the paddock must do so following last car. The track will be uncrossable until all Parade type laps are completed each day. The Car Corral will begin loading cars into the pre-grid area just before lunch. Parade laps with Pace Car will take laps around the track. There may be several groups. The Charity will have a Ferrari enter at Turn 8 past the grandstands twice and exit followed by other Ferraris leading the car corral parade lap groups.

REIMBURSEMENTS: Available for those officials with receipt for gas/hotel for those participating in Race Specialties 2 or more days. The form and receipts must be turned in by Sunday morning at the worker meeting or at registration. Reimbursed amounts are on a sliding scale from \$25-\$300 based on a single round trip drive from home to the track. All forms must be approved by a race chairman.

SPRIDGET CHALLENGE: The final race on Saturday will have a *Faux LeMans Start*. The cars will leave from Pre-Grid and proceed to turn 8 where they will back into position and wait for the flag to wave to start the runners, followed by the cars. A second green will be shown at Start/Finish to confirm the start. Please cheer on these drivers as they race their Sprites and Midgets around the course.

- ★ **RACE RESULTS / RACE HERO:** SOVREN is using RaceHero with live timing. Available for your Android, Apple, or Laptop. Check it out in your App store or <http://racehero.io>

- ★ **PA ANNOUNCEMENTS:** The PA system at Pacific Raceways only works in a very select area because of the local neighbors. You can tune your radio to **540 AM** or **98.5 FM** to hear schedule changes, calls to pre-grid and other announcements.

SPECTATORS:

- ★ **TICKETS:** \$25 One or Three-day Adult ticket / \$5 children between 7 – 16 years old / Children 6 and under free. With ID: \$15 Senior 65-99 / \$10 military & First Responders / Centenarians Free / Birthday on July 4th free

- ★ **SPECTATOR TRACK CROSSING:** Open at Turn 10 access through the gate by ticket booth. Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

PADDOCK SERVICES:

- ★ **AID STATION:** If you or your crew experiences any injury or health problem that needs first aid, there will be an Aid Station located at the east end of Vendor row. Serious problems should be reported to Driver Services who can radio the onsite medical personnel.
- ★ **RESTROOMS:** Pacific Raceways provides 3 permanent restroom buildings in the paddock. The restrooms at the West End of the Paddock have coin operated showers (near the car corral). There are also restrooms near the concession stand and at the east end near the fuel pumps. Port-a-potties may be available in other areas.
- ★ **SOUVENIRS:** The PNWH Vintage Racing Charities may have booths located in the Paddock Shirts, hats, backpacks, posters, etc.
- ★ **CONCESSION STAND:** The track has a new concessionaire this year. They will be open to serve the paddock along with other Food Trucks. Please stop by and say thank you to Ben.
- ★ **VENDOR ROW:** Multiple Vendors (of all types) will be in Vendor Row located along the south side of the paddock. Please visit their booths and thank them for coming.
