If you have ever wanted to be a part of amateur road racing, **SCCA Club Racing** has a place waiting for you.

Welcome to Roebling Road Raceway and the Buccaneer Region's Drivers School and to SARRC racing in 2026. For those of you racing on Sunday, it will be a great opportunity to begin your road racing journey and to start accumulating points towards the 2026 South Atlantic Road Racing Championship. We cannot wait to see you at the racetrack. For the students, we are excited to help you take your first steps toward wheel-to-wheel racing.

Registration at the track will open at 3:00 on Thursday, February 19th for the Drivers School and for Tech Inspection.

For Driver School Students, please remember to complete the 2 on-line Drivers School Training courses and Test before arriving at the track.

Additionally, for the Drivers School Students, please keep in mind the most important thing is for you to get track time. Make sure your car is prepared prior to leaving home and please bring crew with you to assist with your race car while you are in the classroom or with your instructor.

Speaking of crew, on Friday the 20th there will be a **Crew Training Session** from **8:30 to 9:30** for new or existing crew members to discuss and learn how to better support their drivers. This is the first time this has been offered and it should be both fun and educational.

For the SARRC drivers, Sunday's races may be your and others first outing this season. Therefore, please be respectful of your fellow drivers, especially those new drivers who just completed their driver's school on Saturday. We want everyone to have plenty of green flag laps of racing and to be able to drive their cars back on the trailer Sunday for the return home.

All drivers, please look at and be familiar with **Appendix "P" Racing Room & Passing Guidelines**. This is found in your GCR and has been updated for 2026. This is an important addition to the GCR created by drivers for drivers and officials to use as a guide for on track behavior and incidents.

Please remember **GCR 6.11.1 "Rules of the Road"** and if involved in a metal-to-metal incident on track during a session it is your responsibility to report to the Chief Steward or the Operating Steward at the end of the session.

Qualifying and Race Results will be available by scanning the QR Code in the Supplemental Regulations and may also be posted on the Bulletin Board at the end of the covered garages. In addition, Sound Control will post sound readings on this same board.

Watch for announcements via the track's PA or by email blast through MSR for any schedule changes that may be required during the weekend.

There will be a brief in-person **Driver's Meeting** held at approximately **12:00 noon** on **Saturday** in the classroom in the track's maintenance building located near turn 4. *Please attend this meeting.*

There will be a **Social** Saturday evening at the conclusion of on track activities at the Concession building. There will be food and beverages provided. You, your crew, family and friends are encouraged to attend. This is a great opportunity to congratulate our newest drivers, but more importantly to thank all of our volunteer workers. They are some of your biggest fans.

Please be mindful of the track's neighbors and observe the speed limit as you come and go from the track.

In closing, if you have any questions during the weekend I will be located, when not in the classroom for the school, in or around the Tech area.

Again, we are glad you have chosen to attend Buccaneer Region's Driver's School and the Southeast Division's SARRC Series race. Please stay safe and have fun both on and off the track this weekend.
