<u>WELCOME!</u> The SCCA strives to ensure that ALL participants in its events and activities enjoy a welcoming environment. The SCCA supports equality of opportunity and treatment for all participants, regardless of gender, gender identity or expression, race, color, national or ethnic origin, religion or religious belief, age, marital status, sexual orientation, disabilities, or veteran status. A commitment to a welcoming environment is expected of all its members and attendees, including drivers, workers, crew, guests, staff, contractors and exhibitors, and other participants at SCCA activities, sessions and social events and when representing the SCCA in print or electronic media.

NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS: In light of the current COVID-19 situation, every attempt will be made to minimize the risks of exposure to the virus. New processes and procedures are being developed and will be put into place for events going forward.

Ultimately, it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on-track and off, and to make the decision on whether or not to participate. If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath please stay home. If you have been in contact with someone who has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

While on site please take the health and safety of your fellow participants, volunteers and staff into consideration and practice social distancing, people who are not fully vaccinated should wear a mask, and wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently.

All attendees and participants are reminded to be respectful of others and follow these guidelines: people who are not fully vaccinated should wear a mask and all people should adhere to social distancing guidelines at all times while on the track property. Those individuals not adhering to these guidelines or whatever other requirements that may be imposed, will be given a warning to comply and if they continue to be non-compliant they may be asked to leave the facility.

If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within two (2) weeks of attending an SCCA event, we ask that you notify the event Ambassador / Registrar immediately.

<u>RULES:</u> This event is held under the 2021 SCCA Track Event Rules; the category specifications as amended by any subsequent racing bulletins listed in FasTrack during the year 2021. These rules can be found at https://www.scca.com/downloads/44505-2020-scca-track-event-rules.

Roebling Road Raceway Rules and Regulations are in effect and will be enforced during this event.

AMBASSADOR / REGISTRATION: This event is open to Drivers, Entrants, Crew, Officials, and Workers only. All Drivers, Entrants, Crew, Officials, and Workers must be pre-registered at www.motorsportreg.com. Registration closes on Wednesday August 11 2021 at 12:00 PM. Email questions to Ambassador / Registrar Betsy Speed at bspeeding@hotmail.com or telephone at 704-575-5960. No phone calls after 9:00 PM.

Entry fee for the Summer Haze Track Event is \$150.00 per Driver / per car. Additional fee per additional Driver per car will be \$75.00 per additional Driver / per car to cover additional sanction fees and insurance fees. Credit / Debit cards only will be accepted as payment for entry fees. Credit / Debit card payment information must be submitted when the Driver or Entrant enters a car at www.motorsportreg.com. Paper check and cash payment is not available. Credit / Debit cards will be charged when the Driver / Entrant arrives at the Registration window at the track. Any Driver / Entrant who withdraws their entry before their car actually enters the pit road or enters the track must contact the Ambassador / Registrar at the track during Registration open hours to arrange for a refund.

All Drivers must be an SCCA member. All Drivers, Entrants, Crew, Officials, and Workers must have a SCCA Annual Waiver on file at SCCA or must sign a SCCA Waiver Form at the Registration window during registration hours to be issued a Credential for admission to the event.

<u>PERSONAL ID:</u> -All persons must have photo identification in their possession. All persons must wear arm bands on their membership card or their wrist only.

<u>PASSES:</u> Each Track Event car entry is limited to no more than 5 people, including the Driver / Entrant, and Crew. Workers and Officials will be granted one guest pass each. All people who are not SCCA members will be required to purchase a full or weekend membership at registration or through SCCA at www.scca.com to gain access to the trackside of the pit fence.

OPEN GATE HOURS: Friday August 13, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. through Sunday August 15, 2021 6:00 p.m.

<u>DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:</u> All Drivers must be an SCCA member. All Drivers must have a valid driver's license issued in their state of residence. All Drivers who are less than 18 years of age must meet the requirements of Minor Drivers in Section II - Drivers of the 2021 SCCA Track Event Rules. An SCCA competition license or novice permit is not required. All Drivers will be grouped based on previous Track Event experience. Track Event experience will be reviewed by the Event Lead, the Driver Coach, or their designee, prior to participation. Drivers may be required to provide proof of experience, prior to receiving approval to participate.

<u>CAR ELIGIBILITY:</u> Street licensed vehicles are eligible to be entered in this Track Event. At a minimum, all cars must conform to Safety Level 1 standards as defined in the 2021 SCCA Track Event Rules. Open wheel and sports racer competition type vehicles are not eligible to participate in this Track Event. High center of gravity (HCG) vehicles such as SUVs, pick-up trucks, and vans are not eligible to participate in this Track Event. Race cars that are entered in the Summer Haze Double SARRC are not eligible to be entered in the Track Event.

Tech Inspection: It is highly recommended that all entrants have their vehicle Tech inspected prior to Sunday morning. Check the schedule for the times Tech will be open. You must take your vehicle, your Registration Sheet (issued at Registration), and a signed and completed Track Event Tech Sheet (found at the bottom of these Sups) to Tech Inspection.


DRIVER MEETING, ORIENTATION AND TRAINING: There is a mandatory Driver Meeting at 8:30 AM Sunday August 15. All Drivers are required to attend the Driver Meeting. Orientation and Training will immediately follow the Driver Meeting.

RUN GROUPS: There is a hard cap of 40 cars in total for this Track Event, with those 40 cars divided into two separate run groups. Each Track Event run group will be granted three 20 minute sessions, for a total of 60 minutes per run group. Which Drivers will run in which Track Event run group will be determined by the Event Lead, with the determination being based on Driver experience.

<u>RECONNAISSANCE LAPS:</u> Reconnaissance laps provide Track Event Drivers the opportunity to drive the track at a slow speed as they are led around the course at a controlled rate of speed by the Pace Car, with no passing allowed. Cars will remain in single file and must maintain the speed established by the Pace Car. Reconnaissance laps may be scheduled at the discretion of the Event Lead.

PASSING: Passing will be permitted only in the three (3) zones as noted on the track map and only after the Driver of the overtaken car acknowledges with a hand signal or a directional signal that the overtaking car may pass. The overtaken Driver shall indicate on which side of the car the pass should occur. The Track Event lead will determine which passing zones will be in use during this Track Event. The Track Event lead will determine which Driver Groups may pass in which passing zones. Some Driver Groups may not be allowed to pass in all passing zones.

The "passing zones" are designated with traffic cones on Driver's left off the track surface near the edge of the pavement: GREEN to designate the beginning of the passing zone and ORANGE to designate the end of the passing zone. All passes must be started after the GREEN cone and must be completed before the end of the passing zone as marked by the ORANGE cone. Slower cars must allow faster cars to pass in the designated passing zones. Failure to adhere to these passing procedures may result in a Black Flag given to either Driver or to both Drivers.



OFF COURSE EXCURSIONS AND SPINS: Any vehicle driving off the paved course or spinning off course shall return to the course under the direction of Flagging and Communications Workers. Any vehicle that drives off course or spins off course shall proceed safely to the Pit for discussion with Track Event officials and for vehicle inspection.

DRIVER EQUIPMENT: Driver Equipment shall conform to the Driver Equipment standards defined in the 2021 SCCA Track Event Rules.

<u>PASSENGERS, COACHES, IN CAR INSTRUCTORS:</u> Passengers, Coaches, and In Car Instructors are **not permitted** to ride on the track along with Drivers in this event. Only the Driver may be present in any vehicle that enters pit road or enters the track.

<u>ROLL BARS:</u> Street licensed convertibles / retractable top / targa top or T top vehicles shall conform to the roll bar requirements specified in the Safety Level 1 standards as defined in the 2021 SCCA Track Event Rules.

<u>TOW HOOKS</u>: All cars should have a front and rear tow hook that is already attached or can be quickly attached so that the car can be easily towed. Cars that do not have hard front and rear tow hook attachments must carry an axle strap that is safely stored somewhere in the car.

<u>CAMERAS</u>: The use of any cameras, including video cameras, are restricted to "in-car" attachment only as recommended by their manufacturer. The attachment must be made in a secure manner. Suction mounting alone is not secure.

<u>RESTRAINT SYSTEMS:</u> A minimum of a 3 point safety belt / harness is required of all vehicles. Vehicles that were originally equipped with only a 2 point system must be equipped with a 3 point safety belt / harness.

TIRES: All cars must have tires rated for a minimum of 130 MPH (H) designation without visible safety defects.

WINDOWS: All cars must have both the Driver side and Passenger side windows fully down at any time the car is on the track.

START/FINISH & TIMING: Start and finish of all sessions is at the tower on the front straight. Transponders are not required. There be no official "timing" of any vehicle during the event.

<u>CHECKERED FLAG & BLACK FLAGS</u>: Checkered flags and Black flags with number board will be displayed at the START/FINISH line and at the Turn 6 flag station. All cars will proceed immediately to pit in when the Checkered flag or the Black flag is displayed, and will not take another lap.

<u>CAR NUMBERS & CLASSES:</u> Numbers must be on both sides of the vehicle, be legible and be at least 8 inches tall with a 1.5 inch stroke and in a contrasting color to the vehicle. There will be no designated classes for this event.


<u>COMMUNICATIONS:</u> Race Control uses digital radios on **461.825**, **461.025**, **and 464.100 MHz** as licensed for the immediate area by the FCC. For the safety of competitors and race staff, failure to keep these frequencies clear will result in immediate action under the rights specified in the GCR. **DO NOT USE THESE FREQUENCIES FOR PERSONAL COMMUNICATIONS.** Teams are encouraged to monitor race control and alert their Drivers of conditions in their track sessions. Announcements from Race Control are broadcast on the paddock PA system and on 101.5 FM radio.

<u>SOUND CONTROL</u>: Sound Control is located on Driver's left, just past the Start/Finish line. Maximum sound level is 103 dB per GCR 5.7. Non-compliance is subject to disqualification. 1st instance of sound violation results in a closed black flag shown to dirver. 2nd instance open black flag to Driver and they must report to pit road for further instruction. 3rd violation of sound level results in open black flag and Driver must report to pit road and may not reenter track until problem is fixed. Sound readings will be posted near the Track Manager's office.

<u>UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS:</u> Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAV or Drone) may only be operated at this event with the prior permission of the Track Manager and must be compliant with GCR 2.2.6 Unmanned Aircraft Systems.

Covered Garage spaces are available for rent. Contact Roebling Road track management for details and pricing.
