## SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

This event is governed by the 2023 General Competition Rules (GCR) and Category Specifications, as amended for 2023 per "Fastrack" and these Supplemental Regulations."

## **I. REGISTRATION and FEES**

**A. TEST DAY:** GingerMan Raceway is holding a test day on Friday, July 14. This is NOT covered by SCCA sanction or insurance. For more information, click here.

- C. PAYMENTS & REFUNDS: Drivers must register for the race online by clicking <u>here</u>. For registration questions, contact the registrar, Mary Shiloff at <u>mshiloff@comcast.net</u>. If a driver never enters the track and would like a refund, they must contact the registrar via email.
- **D. PASSES:** Each entry must list their crew members on the entry form. Each driver is allowed three free crew passes. Additional passes are available for \$10. If a crew member arrives outside registration hours, they must pay the GingerMan spectator fee at the gate. All entrants/crew must either possess an SCCA Annual Waiver or sign the SpeedWaiver before or at the time of registration (<a href="https://sbrscca.speedwaiver.com/lshah">https://sbrscca.speedwaiver.com/lshah</a>).
- **E. ELECTRIC HOOKUP/GARAGE RESERVATION:** Contact GingerMan Raceway at (269) 253-4445 or maribeth@gingermanraceway.com to rent a garage or obtain electric hookup.
- **F. PREFERRED NUMBERS:** Every effort will be made to honor Conference Preferred Numbers until 14 days before the event. However, due to the make-up of the run groups, this may not be possible in all situations. If two drivers holding the same Preferred Number request that number for the same run group, the number will be assigned to the driver with the earliest request.
- **G. PADDOCK/PARKING INFORMATION:** The paddock opens at 3:00 pm on Thursday. All parking is first come first served with the exception of the 14 spots with electric hookup. All competitors parked in the main paddock must use "pull-in" parking unless other arrangements have been made with the race chair. Race cars may park on the asphalt extension of the inner-loop of the main paddock as long as two-way traffic pattern is retained. No parking is allowed on the asphalt in the grid area located north of the main paddock.

### II. DRIVER INFORMATION

**A. DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:** Each driver must be a current member of the SCCA and hold an SCCA Full Competition license to participate in this event. If you do not have the proper credentials, it is your responsibility to contact the Registrar prior to the event.









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- B. CAR ELIGIBILITY: Competition is open to all Runoffs eligible classes per the GCR 3.1.1.E.1.
- C. TIMING & SCORING: All cars are required to use fully operational MyLaps (formerly AMB) transponders, and the driver is responsible for providing correct information to Timing & Scoring. Make sure your transponder is on and functioning for ALL SESSIONS. Information gathered from personal timing and data collection systems is unofficial and will not be used by race officials. Cars without working Transponders will not be timed.
- **D. BLACK FLAG:** Black Flag stations will be located at Turn #7 and the Starters Stand. Drivers receiving a Black Flag will enter pit lane and proceed to the Black Flag station in front of the control tower.
- **E. SOUND CONTROL:** A maximum limit of 103 dB is in effect for this event. Sound readings will be taken on the driver's left between turns 2 and 3. Sound readings will be available at Driver Information.
- **F. HARDSHIP LAPS:** Please contact the Chief Steward.
- **G. AWARDS:** Trophies for all races will be awarded in accordance with the GCR. Trophies will be presented at the event. SCCA U.S. Majors Tour points will be awarded in accordance with the GCR and these Supplemental Regulations.
- H. LANE AUTOMOTIVE CONTINGENCY: Lane Automotive will provide a total of \$800 in product certificates for competitors displaying the "Lane Automotive" or "Allstar Performance" decals on each side of the car. Winners will be determined by random drawing. Decals must be displayed before Saturday's race to be eligible. Decals can be picked up at registration or Driver Information. Lane Automotive is located 30 minutes south of the track. Lane Automotive is a premier supplier of performance parts and accessories for racers, hot-rodders and off-road enthusiasts. - **I. VICTORY LAPS**: Due to time constraints there will be no victory laps.

#### III. CAR SAFETY and TECH INSPECTION

## A. TECH INSPECTION:

- All drivers without a current year helmet sticker must present all driver gear as required by the GCR, vehicle logbook, and completed tech card to Tech. If your car requires an annual tech OR you have Logbook notations, you must bring the car to Tech. Contact Chief of Tech, Rod Markowicz, rodionjm@yahoo.com. Annual Tech will be located in the lower level of the Timing and Communications Tower.
- 2. U.S. MAJORS TOUR EXPRESS TECH will also be <u>available</u> in the <u>pavilion on Friday</u> for those cardholders. Drivers that have a valid Annual Tech, 2023 Helmet sticker and no notations in their logbook will only need to bring their logbook and completed tech form to Express Tech or to Tech at the pavilion (Friday) or base of the tower (Saturday/Sunday) to receive their event "tech" sticker.
- **B. DECALS:** Competition vehicles must also display the official SCCA Road Racing decal per GCR section 9.3.29.C (Figure 4.) Stickers will be provided free of charge and may be obtained at registration and/or tech. (The official SCCA Summit Racing Equipment Road Racing decal does not serve as the Summit Racing Equipment contingency program decal.)
- C. DATA ACQUISITION: U.S. Majors Tour staff and their delegates may install data acquisition equipment in a competitor's car. This program is to assist the CRB in performance balancing. If selected, participation is not optional and is not protestable. The data collected from the device will not be used for compliance purposes. All cars carrying an SCCA data collection device must report to impound after their session. Failure to do so may result in penalties.
- **D. SCALES:** Will be available at Tech 30 minutes after Registration opens on Saturday and Sunday. Scales may be made available during race impound, but priority will be given to impounded cars.
- E. SPEC MIATA COMPLIANCE: At post-race inspection, Spec Miata participants may be instructed by the designated Class Compliance Chief (CCC) to remove parts, including but not limited to the cylinder head, for disassembly and/or inspection. Competitors are responsible for performing required disassembly and/or reassembly of their car, as well as any resulting expenses incurred. The CCC will report any findings of









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non-compliance to the Chief Steward, who will then determine the need for a Chief Steward's Action (CSA) or Request for Action (RFA).

### **IV. QUALIFYING**

### A. GRID:

- 1. Qualifying 1 starting positions are first come first served. Qualifying 2 will be determined by fastest lap in qualifying 1 or race 1.
- 2. Race 1 (Saturday): Grid positions for race 1 will be determined by the driver's fastest lap in qualifying 1.
- 3. Race 2 (Sunday): Grid positions for race 2 will be determined by the driver's fastest lap in qualifying 1, qualifying 2 or race 1.
- **B. QUALIFYING:** A driver not qualifying within a maximum of 120% of the recognized track record of their class must obtain permission from the Chief Steward to race. In the case of unusual circumstances, the Chief Steward can waive this rule for the entire event.

#### V. IMPOUND

- **A. MANDATORY DRIVERS MEETING**: <u>Impound All</u> will be given at the end of the first qualifying session for each group to conduct a driver's meeting. Impound will be in the Tech area.
- B. SPLIT STARTS: The Chief Steward will consider requests for split starts at the driver's meeting.
- **C. IMPOUND**: <u>Saturday & Sunday races</u>: The top three competitors in each class must report to impound immediately following the completion of their race.
- **D. CONTACT:** GCR Section 6.11.1.E requires that the driver and car involved in significant body contact must stop at the designated incident investigation site at the base of the Tower for review of the incident by stewards. Drivers must satisfy this requirement by reporting to the Chief Steward during impound of their sessions. Drivers who do not satisfy this requirement will be referred to the Stewards of the Meeting (SOM).

#### **VI. GENERAL**

- **A. RACE LENGTH:** Saturday races will be 15 laps or 25 minutes. Sunday races will be 21 laps or 40 minutes, When the **LAST LAP INDICATOR** is given at Start/Finish, the next flag will be a checkered flag.
- **B. STARTS:** Starts will be conducted per GCR.









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- C. RACE CLOCK: The race clock will be started for either a timed or lap race when the lead car crosses the time loop/Start-Finish whether or not the race is started or aborted after the prescribed pace lap(s). The race clock will not be stopped unless under a Red Flag situation or directed by the Chief Steward In the case of a long delay and the time limit for either a lapped or timed race has expired, the Chief Steward may convert the race to a specific number of laps to allow for a "Green, White, Checker" to complete the race.
- **D. LAST LAP:** If/When the Last Lap indicator is given at Start/Finish, the next flag at Start/Finish will be a checkered flag. The lack of a last lap indication cannot be protested as a last lap indication is only a courtesy.
- E. RESULTS: Live timing will be available during the event at <a href="https://racehero.io/events">https://racehero.io/events</a>, <a href="https://speedhive.mylaps.com/">https://speedhive.mylaps.com/</a> and <a href="https://www.race-monitor.com/live">https://speedhive.mylaps.com/</a> and <a href="https://www.race-monitor.com/live">https://www.race-monitor.com/live</a>. Live timing information is neither official nor protestable. Results will be available at Driver Information located near the Tower.
- **F. START TIMES:** Schedule times are cars on course.
- **G. EVENT SCHEDULE / RUN GROUPS**: Actual session start times may be delayed from the published schedule due to unforeseen circumstances during the event. It is the driver's responsibility to listen to the PA system and pay attention to activity on track. The schedule or run groups may only be changed (or start times advanced) at the discretion of the Chief Steward, with concurrence by the Event Chair, depending on pre-race entry counts or as needed to accommodate situations during the event.
- **H. CANCELLATION:** If part of an event is canceled for reasons of safety or forces beyond our control as provided by GCR Appendix B 1.2.A., points will be awarded based on race grids.
- I. **CLOTHING:** Safe apparel must be worn in the pits at all times (long pants, sleeved shirts, and closed toe shoes). Crew members on pit lane must display their event credentials at all times while on pit lane.
- J. PIT LANE SPEED: The pit lane speed limit is 40 mph.
- K. TIRE VENDOR: Hoosier Tire Midwest-Plymouth will be servicing this event. In order to provide you with the best service possible, we ask that you place a tire reservation. - L. FUEL PROVIDER: 93, 100 and 110 octane fuel are available at the track.
- M. RADIO FREQUENCIES: South Bend Region operates on frequencies 151.625, 154.640, 154.600, 154.570, 464.500, and 456.800. The repeater receives on 152.870 and transmits on 159.615. These frequencies may be monitored but will not be used for communication by any participant. No other radio frequencies may be transmitted from the tower due to the interference caused with the official track frequencies.

#### **VII. TRACK RULES**

- **A. CAMPING:** Camping is allowed in the paddock on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. The cost is \$10.00 per person per night. Children under 12 are free.
- **B. PETS**: Must be on leashes at all times and owners are responsible for any associated clean up. No pets allowed in the park area around the pond and the pavilion.
- **C. SALE OF PRODUCTS/SERVICES:** You must get track management approval.
- **D. WASTE:** The track property must be left clean. Waste oil must be put in the green tank located near the fuel pumps. Tires should not be left on the track property.
- E. SPEED: The maximum speed limit in the paddock is 10 MPH. Absolutely NO bedding of brakes in the paddock.
- **F. LOAD OUT:** You must depart by 8:00 pm on Sunday. Arrangements must be made with the track management if items must be left after this time.
- **G. ALCOHOL:** The consumption of alcohol is not allowed on track property before the final checkered flag of the day.
