

Ultimately, it is your responsibility to assess the risk to you, both on-track and off, and to make the decision on whether or not to participate. If you are feeling unwell or are experiencing symptoms such as fever, cough, or shortness of breath please stay home. If you have been in contact with someone who has been experiencing these symptoms in the last two weeks, please stay home.

While on site please take the health and safety of your fellow participants, volunteers and staff into consideration and practice social distancing, wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth, and wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer frequently.

If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 within two (2) weeks of attending an SCCA event, we ask that you notify the event Registrar immediately.

SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

This event is governed by the 2021 General Competition Rules (GCR) and Category Specifications, as amended for 2021 per "Fastrack", except as modified by these Supplemental Regulations

I. REGISTRATION and FEES

- A. **TEST DAY:** The test day is provided by Eagles Canyon Raceway and not covered under SCCA event sanction and insurance.
- **B.** ENTRY FEES: Entry Fee for the two-day weekend is \$500. Second entry same driver \$350. Each SRF3. SRF, FE2, FE entry will be charged an additional \$30 and each SM an additional \$20 compliance fee per entry for the weekend. The Runoffs Appearance Fund fee (previously known as a tow fund fee) is included in the entry fee.
- C. PAYMENTS & REFUNDS: Online registration is at the following link <u>http://msreg.com/2021TXFallRoundup</u> An entry is not considered complete until the proper fee is received. Online registration will close Wednesday October 27, 2021 at 11:59 PM. Credit cards will not be processed before October 28, 2021. All entries received prior to October 15, 2021 at 11:59 PM will receive a \$50 early bird discount as a token of our appreciation. A refund will be made if the entry does not go on track. Withdrawal notifications are accepted by email, phone, or in person to the Chief Registrar or via MotorsportReg.com and would be greatly appreciated in advance of the event and no later than noon on Saturday.
- **D. PASSES:** Each entry received five (5) passes total, including the driver and entrant. Workers, guests, & crew must sign for their own passes and must arrive while registration is open. All crew members signing in under a prep shop list must be an SCCA member. Weekend memberships are available for purchase if needed. SCCA members (non-participants) must present a valid membership card for admission.
- E. PADDOCK AND GARAGE RESERVATION:
- F. PREFERRED NUMBERS: Every effort will be made to honor Conference Preferred Numbers until 14 days prior to the event. However, due to the make-up of the run groups, this may not be possible in all situations. If two drivers holding the same Preferred Number request that number for the same run group, the number will be assigned to the driver with the earliest request.

G. PADDOCK/PARKING INFORMATION:

II. DRIVER INFORMATION

A. **DRIVER ELIGIBILITY:** Drivers must be a current member of the SCCA and hold a SCCA Full Competition license or a full SCCA Pro license to participate in this event, or any other eligible License per GCR 3.1.2. If

you do not have the proper credentials it is your responsibility to contact the Registrar prior to the event. If the Race Director allows the substitution of a car or driver, per GCR 5.12.3.A.6, any qualifying times earned for the original car/driver up to that point will be removed.

- **B.** CAR ELIGIBILITY: Competition is open to all cars conforming to the GCR, as amended.
- **C. TIMING & SCORING:** All cars are required to use fully operational MyLaps/AMB TranX260or X2 transponders, and the driver is responsible for providing the correct information to Timing & Scoring. Make sure your transponder is on and functioning for ALL SESSIONS. Information gathered from personal timing and data collection systems is unofficial and will not be used by race officials. Cars without working transponders may not receive times.
- D. COURSE: Eagles Canyon Raceway, 2.7 mile course, Counter-Clockwise.
- E. BLACK FLAG: Pit Lane Exit to Paddock
- F. SOUND CONTROL: Sound Limit 103dB, Sound Control Readings will be posted in Tech. Sound Meter Location to be determined at event and will be posted in Tech.
- **G. WARM-UP SESSIONS/HARDSHIP LAPS:** Competitors who have mechanical problems and need to test their car at speed may be allowed a hardship lap at the discretion of the Chief Steward.
- H. AWARDS: Southwest Division Road Racing Championship points will be awarded per 2021 SWRRC Rules.

III. CAR SAFETY and TECH INSPECTIONS

- A. DECALS: A US Majors Tour decal must be displayed on both sides of all competition vehicles. Competition vehicles must also display the official SCCA Road Racing decal per GCR Section 9.3.28.C (Figure 4). Stickers will be provided free of charge and may be obtained at registration and/or tech. (The official SCCA Summit Racing Equipment Road Racing decal does not serve as the Summit Racing Equipment contingency program decal.)
- **B. TECH:** No smoking or engines running in the Tech Garage. All drivers without a current year helmet sticker must present all driver gear as required by the GCR and vehicle logbook to Tech. If your car requires an annual tech you must also bring the car to Tech.
- **C. SCALES:** Availability of scales and times will be posted at Tech. Scales may be available for other participants during race impound, but priority will be given to impounded cars. Scales may be made available at other times at the discretion of the Chief of Tech.

IV. QUALIFYING/RACE

A. GRID:

Practice: Starting positions for the first sanctioned, official on-track session will be set based on order of arrival at GRID.

Qualifying: Grid positions will be determined using the fastest lap time in the official practice session. **Saturday Race:** Grid position will be determined using the fastest lap time in the Saturday Qualifying session. **Sunday Race:** Grid positions will be determined by the fastest lap time recorded for each car during any of the preceding qualifying session(s) or the fastest lap during the Saturday race.

V. IMPOUND

- A. MANDATORY DRIVERS MEETING: Either a written Drivers' Meeting from Chief Steward may be emailed to all entrants/drivers in advance of the event, or an <u>Impound All</u> will be given at the end of the first Qualifying session for each group to conduct a driver's meeting. Impound will be in the Tech Area. Look for the signs for proper direction.
- B. SPLIT STARTS: The Chief Steward will consider requests for split starts at the Driver's Meeting.
- C. IMPOUND: <u>Saturday races</u>: The top three competitors in each class shall report to impound immediately following the completion of their race. <u>Sunday races</u>: The top three competitors in each class shall report to impound immediately following the completion of their race.
- **D. CONTACT:** GCR Section 6.11.1.E requires that the driver and car, involved in significant body contact, to stop at the designated incident investigation site for review of the incident by steards. Drivers shall satisfy this

requirement by reporting to the Chief Steward during the impound of their session. Drivers who do not satisfy this requirement will be referred to the Stewards of the Meeting (SOM).

VI. GENERAL

- A. RACE LENGTH: Saturday races will be 25 minutes. Sunday races will be 25. When the LAST LAP INDICATOR is given at Start/Finish, the next flag will be a checkered flag. In the case of a long delay and where the time limit has expired, the Chief Steward may convert to laps to allow a green, white, checker to complete the race.
- **B. RESULTS:** Live timing will be available during the event through <u>Race Monitor</u>, and may be available at <u>SCCA.com</u>. Live timing information is neither official nor protestable. Results will only be available at <u>TX</u> <u>Region Road Racing</u> or by using the QR code at the end of these supplemental regulations.
- **C. EVENT SCHEDULE/RUN GROUPS:** Actual session start times may be delayed from the published schedule due to unforeseen circumstances during the event. It is the driver's responsibility to listen to the PA system and pay attention to activity on track. The schedule or run groups may only be changed (or start times advanced) at the discretion of the Chief Steward, with concurrence by the Event Chair, depending on pre-race entry counts or as needed to accommodate situations during the event.
- **D. CANCELLATION:** If part of an event is cancelled for reasons of safety or forces beyond our control as provided by GCR Appendix B.1.2.B., points will be awarded based on race grids.
- **E. CLOTHING:** Safe apparel must be worn in the pits at all times. Crew members on pit lane must display their event credential at all times while on pit lane.
- F. GRID: All motorized vehicles (race cars and support vehicles) must enter the grid area from the designated traffic flow signage.
- G. PIT LANE: Drivers are to maintain a safe speed on Pit Lane with absolutely no racing.

- I. FUEL PROVIDER: Available at Track SUNOCO 93 Unleaded \$3.30/gal 100 Unleaded \$9.00/gal 110 Leaded \$9.00/gal

VII. TRACK RULES

- A. Gates close on the track immediately after the last scheduled run session. The track is considered cold, and no person is allowed to enter without express consent from ECR.
- B. Only ECR personnel may open and close the track gates prior to and after an event.
- C. No alcohol consumption is allowed while track is in use by anyone on the grounds in the facility.
- D. No one under the age of eighteen is permitted to operate a motorized vehicle unless they are registered with the event.
- E. Speed limit in the paddock is 15 mph.
- F. No parking between and around garage buildings.
- G. Do not leave used tires at our facility, take them with you or pay a disposal fee at one of the shops on site.
- H. Dispose of used oil in the waste oil container on site. Ask at the front desk for location.
- I. In the case of rain or mud, all vehicles must stay on pavement.
- J. Animals must remain on leash at all times, must be cleaned up after and not allowed in the clubhouse.
- K. No climbing the hill slopes above pit lane.
- L. No spectators beyond the posted limits on the grounds.
- M. Paddock grounds are managed by ECR staff during operating hours of 7:00 AM 5:30 PM. The property entry gates are closed after and prior to these hours. Camping is allowed, however, the contracted sanctioned renting party is responsible for operational security on the grounds during closed hours, if they have registered drivers staying on the grounds. Gates MUST be closed at 10:00 PM and opened no earlier than 6:00 AM by the sanctioned group renting the property
