



CALABOGIE SPRING CLASSIC – June 21-23, 2024

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Organized by Calabogie Motorsports Park and the Ottawa SportsCar Club and run under ASN Canada Regulations (FEL), Code Sportif ASQ (SPC), CASC-OR Race Regulations and GCR's, these Supplementary Regulations, and as described in the Driver Meetings.

SCHEDULE

- **Mandatory Driver Meeting for Formula Libre** will be at 8:30AM on Saturday, June 22 beside the stairs of Race Control Building #4. All other series will hold their own Drivers Meeting. Check with the series for their schedule.
- **Test Day Registration** will be open **Friday June 21: 7:00 - 9:00AM. Race Registration** will be open **Friday, June 21: 3:00 - 5:00PM; Saturday, June 22: 7:00 - 9:00AM; Sunday, June 23: 8:30 - 9:00AM.** Inquiries outside of these hours, please contact the CMP Office, 2nd Floor, Building #5 across from Pit Exit.
- CMP reserves the right to modify the official schedule with respect to order, length and/or groupings of any session.
- **Scrutineering** - Open Friday June 21: 3:00 - 7:00PM; Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd: 8:00AM - closed after last race of the day.
- **Weekend Schedule** is a Time-Certain schedule. No track announcements will be made except in cases of changes.

GENERAL RULES

- All persons entering a restricted area as defined by spectator fences, signage or other means and including Pit Lane, Pit Boxes, False Grid and Trackside must wear the appropriate identifying wristband issued by CMP.
- Race Entry includes 4 Crew wristbands that will be valid for the weekend. Additional Crew passes are available at a cost of \$35 for the weekend. Additional passes can be purchased at the Registration Office located in Building 5 on the 2nd floor or at the Main Gate on Saturday morning opening for sales at 8:00 AM.
- Photographers requiring track-side access must register to receive a photo vest + Photo credential to wear at all times.
- No parking is permitted on the False Grid (excluding properly gridded race cars) or on any of the service lanes.
- The permitted sound level for the weekend is 104 dB between the hours of 9:00AM - 5:00PM Friday; 9:00AM - 6:30PM Saturday; and 9:00AM - 6:00PM Sunday. To ensure compliance, CMP will perform random measurements of vehicles on track on a full acceleration pass from a minimum distance of 50 feet. A mandatory noise restriction that includes no operation of competition engines is in effect from 10:00PM to 7:00AM every day.
- **ANY** transfer of fuel must include a separate designated person whose sole function shall be to oversee the refueling process while holding an appropriate and armed fire extinguisher. Refueling shall not be performed under an awning or where fumes could accumulate.
- Flying Drones are not permitted on the grounds of Calabogie Motorsports Park.

PADDOCK

- The paddock includes the paved and adjacent areas between the track and the facility outer chain-link fence, or as designated by race officials.
- Paddock hours are **Thursday June 20: 5:00 - 10:00PM; Friday + Saturday 7:00AM - 10:00PM; Sunday 7:00AM – 7:00PM.**
No Move in before 5PM Thursday.
- Only vehicles with a parking pass are permitted in the paddock. Absolutely no parking is permitted directly in front of Building #5 or Race Medical in Building #1. All Team Vehicles and trailers will be positioned by CMP Staff and only during the published hours. No reservations are allowed for paddock space. If you wish to paddock beside another competitor, you must both arrive at the same time. You are only allowed your trailer, race car(s) and ONE support vehicle in the paddock.
- **NO** tent pegs may be used on the paved portions of the paddock. Weights, or other like non-intrusive devices, must be used to secure tents, tarps, or similar. All jack stands must be placed on a plywood base to prevent damage to the paddock pavement. Participants will be responsible for any damages.
- Traffic flow is **ONE WAY unless otherwise posted** for all wheeled conveyances!! **Observe the signs! Paddock speed limit is 15 kph.**
- **All competitors and their equipment MUST vacate the Paddock by Sunday, June 23 at 7:00PM unless prior arrangements have been made with Calabogie Motorsports Park.**

LOCATION OF IN-PADDOCK SERVICES

- The **False Grid** for all sessions will be in the upper paddock beside the spectator fence between the pit lane and the paddock. Only enter the False Grid from the entrance at Building #1.
- **Formula Libre Scrutineering** is located in the Upper Paddock near the gas pumps. The FEL and SPC Scrutineering locations will be provided by the Series.
- The **Official Notice Board for Formula Libre** will be under the Calabogie track map in the Upper Paddock beside Building #3. Results and Competitor Services will be available in the same area or, in the case of inclement weather, inside Building #3 directly behind the podium.
- The Safety Kleen **waste fluids disposal** facility is located at the southwest corner of Building #5 next to the Sound Booth and beside the chain-link fence west of the Main Entrance.
- **Race Medical** is in East Garage area in Building #1.

2024 Calabogie Spring Classic

ON TRACK

- All sessions will be conducted exclusively on the 'Long Track'.
- The 'Green Flag' for the start of all races and the Last Lap board will be displayed from the Starter's Stand, Driver's Left on the 'Pit Straight'.
- The **Black** and **Mechanical Black Flag** will be displayed from the Starter's Stand and the Flag Station at Corner 15.
- The **Penalty Box** will be in the last pit before the pit exit into the paddock and marked with orange cones for reference.
- The **Pits Closed** sign, if required, will be displayed at Corner 15. Pit Exit will be closed during a Full Course Yellow when the Pace Car passes the Starter's Stand and will re-open when the last car in the group behind the safety car has passed Pit Exit.
- For Practice and Qualifying, **Black Flag All** (waved black flags at all stations) – proceed to Pit Lane and stop in your Pit Box.
- For races, **Red Flag** – proceed to Pit Lane and stop in the fast lane (right lane).
- Emergency and Service Vehicles may be dispatched onto a 'Hot Track' at any time, in any session and from any location without a Full Course Yellow or a Red Flag stoppage.
