
Numbers indicate Worker Station



Autocross Event – RULES

- 1. Safety Steward Mike Glass
- 2. President-John Juhring, VP-Mike Glass, Treasurer-Chris Davie, Secretary-Aspen Padilla
- 3. No smoking on course or in grid.
- 4. Pick up your garbage. Let's leave the site cleaner than we found it.
- 5. Get registered and get car tech'ed as soon as you arrive. Make sure to get at least 2 course walks.
- 6. Rules
 - a. Grid Cars will form two lines facing towards start.
 - b. There will also be a short Dual Driver line at the front of grid (see map).
 - c. Be sure to follow the same car each time to start line. If you need to pull out of line for any reason, please notify a club officer or radio worker.
 - d. Cone penalties
 - i. Cone that is knocked over is a penalty.
 - ii. Cone that is still standing and touching the box is clean. Course worker replace the cone to the middle of the box.
 - iii. Cone outside the box and not touching the box is a penalty. Course worker replace the cone to the middle of the box.
 - iv. Cones that are already down, are not a penalty. For example, if a cone with a pointer is hit, it is a 1 cone penalty.
 - e. How to call in a penalty: Station number, car number, number of penalties.
 - f. The station worker with radio also carries the red flag. This worker should not shag cones. The other station workers should spread out and replace all hit cones. If several cones are hit, ask to 'hold start' so your runners can replace all cones before the next car.
 - g. Runners at the work stations will need to <u>run</u> to replace cones. Especially near the cross-over as cars will be passing through this section of the course twice. If it is not safe to replace the cone, request the radio person to 'Hold Start'.
 - h. If there is an unsafe situation on course where a car stops or stalls and cannot get going prior to the next car starting, or a spectator or vehicle or animal wanders on course, CALL RED FLAG on the radio. If one red flag is called, all stations wave the Red Flag.
 - i. **If you drive, you must work**. It's a courtesy to the other drivers who worked while you drove, and a requirement to receive points and be allowed to attend future events.
 - j. Work assignments were emailed out and are posted at the Timing Trailer.
 - k. You may have one passenger when on course. Passenger must also sign the release waiver and have a wristband. Passenger must wear an approved helmet. Make sure they keep their hands and elbows inside the car. No phone or camera in hands. There may be other restrictions with Covid-19.
 - I. Everyone is to stay away from the timing trailer when cars are on course. If you have any questions come see the Event Chairs, Safety Steward or Club officers outside timing trailer.
 - m. When exiting the course, you must come to a complete stop before re-entering the access road. There could be cross traffic or pedestrians. <u>However, exit the stop box quickly.</u>
 - n. Anyone inside the Caution Tape perimeter must wear a wristband.
